### Minutes

1. Information on SIG pages and social groups were shared. Members strongly expressed their desire to be able to access SIG information on the EuroCALL website without having to sign in as a member. Questions were raised around the rationale behind the current gated access.  
**ACTION:** We have already expressed our concerns with gated access to the SIG web pages. We will report to EuroCALL similar concerns raised by our members to have open access to our SIG pages. We see this as a way of encouraging EuroCALL membership. 2. Information on SIG communication channels were shared. Having a EuroCALL CMC SIG Facebook group was discussed. We agreed to keep the community together and post information and events on the EuroCALL Facebook group, but also on CALICO CMC Facebook group.
3. Teresa shared reflections on last year's SIG meeting, which was chaired by Shannon Sauro, and summarised our continued collaboration with her. The interest expressed in the sig at this year's conference was very impressive, workshops ("Research methods in CMC" and "CMC in the Open") were well attended and provided helpful expertise to an interested audience.
4. Information on the Show & Tell webinars we organised was shared. Recordings of these events are shared on an [open Google Document](#). The link (shared here) can be found on our SIG page. Teresa had also worked with other SIGs to help them prepare video presentations about their activities, these have been made available as mp4 files to the sig chairs and also supplied to Eurocall for the new website. If members would like to share their research in a further Show & Tell event, please get in touch with us and we will be glad to organise more events this year. A request was made for a multi-lingual show and tell in the future to encourage participation from colleagues who are not confident to present in English and to broaden access to other linguistic communities. Another way forward could be to organise joint webinars with the CALICO CMC SIG or as part of the IALLT webinar series.

5. We discussed future directions for the community for next year. Members indicated interest in further Show & Tell online events, but also reflecting on our Research Methods in CMC

workshop, in face-to-face workshops/events focused on research. It was suggested that these could be small-size, localised hands-on data workshops or events working on research projects and for collaboration potentially leading to publications. However, finding funding for these events could be a challenge. We are open to any suggestions from members who would be willing to host a CMC SIG workshop. Another suggestion was setting up Erasmus partnerships for bilateral exchanges to share research expertise and promote collaboration.
